
## MALE CONTRACEPTION

## **CURRENT**



No! Disparity in number of options forces woman to bear most of the responsibility for protection, both financial and health-wise.

No! If women make all the decisions regarding contraception, men actually lose some control or autonomy over the choice






Men have 2 options including condoms and a vasectomy. Other options such as early withdrawal

- and the rhythm method (following a woman's regular menstrual cycle) are not considered reliable birth control options.
- Failure Rate of Condoms 12% (Failure can be attributed to breakage and slippage.)

Vasectomy Reversal Success - 88% (Optimal reversal success rate should be closer to 100%)





Possible Solutions

Ideal male contraception options would be similar to women's **choices**: independent of act itself, minimal health side effects such as low sex drive or testosterone levels, and be cost effective.

Current possible solutions include a hormone pill and/or gel to suppress sperm production.
